Resolution: G.R. 17 (F) 3 – Bill to Codify Graduate Student Assembly Agencies’ Bylaws

WHEREAS (1): The Graduate Student Assembly is governed by a Constitution and Bylaws detailing the responsibilities of all members, and,

WHEREAS (2): The Graduate Student Assembly (GSA) has six agencies to function as student advocacy groups in specialized areas; they are the Entrepreneurship and Innovation Agency (E&I), Graduate Student Health Agency (GSHA), International Student Agency (ISA), Queer Graduate Students Alliance (QGSA), Undergraduate Membership Agency (UMA), and Voting Graduate Student Agency (VGSA); and,

WHEREAS (3): These ad hoc agencies have been acting with general practices but no official structure to guide their continued function; and,

WHEREAS (4): These agencies receive funding through the GSA and should be held accountable to a codified purpose and allowable actions in official bylaws; now,


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT (1): The bylaws for E&I, GSHA, ISA, QGSA, UMA, and VGSA will be added into Article VII of the GSA Bylaws; and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT (2): These bylaws will be sent to the Office of the Dean of Graduate Students and the Vice President for Student Affairs for approval; and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT (3): The updated bylaws will be added to the GSA official website governing documents for student and public reference.
